

How to do Voter Registration in your Church?

The General Election is November 4, 2014. Sign up to register voters at least twice on the following dates of September 21 & 28 and October 5 & 12 2014. Educate your congregation about the deadline to register voters on October 14, 2014. Absentee Ballot Application must be received by 5:00 p.m. on October 31, 2014 to vote in November 4, 2014 General Election by mail.

What you will need to do:

- 1) Ask for permission from your pastor to conduct a non-partisan voter registration drive.
- 2) Announce voter registration dates in church bulletin, slides and announcements from Pastor if possible.
- 3) Set up a voter registration table with balloons or an American flag in a prominent area of your church (preferably near the exit) Make sure to have extra pens

- 5) Print off Kansas Voter Registration Forms-

- 6) Enlist help from volunteers to help with set up and question

Either mail or hand- carry to your local election office.

Important Dates

OCTOBER

Tuesday, October 14-Last day to register to vote in general election.

Wednesday, October 15-Advance voting begins for general election.

Friday, October 31-Deadline for voters to apply for advance voting ballot to be mailed.

NOVEMBER

Tuesday, November 4 (General Election)-Advance voting ballots must be received in office of County Election Officer by close of polls.
